



Crucial Pastel Painting Techniques for Beginners




Pastels come in two varieties – oil pastels and chalk pastels. Both are quick to use and easy to control.


Chalk pastel are soft and can be blended with your finger or a cotton bud. Oil pastels are blended by applying one colour on top of the other.

Pastels work best on a rough paper. Coloured paper or black paper make effective backgrounds. You could prepare a background by rubbing the side of a pastel across it before starting your drawing.









COMPLEMENTARY COLOURS

one of a pair of primary or <u>secondary</u>
<u>colours</u> opposed to the other member of the pair on
a schematic chart or scale (colour wheel),


as green opposed to red, orange opposed to blue, or violet opposed to yellow.

the relationship of these pairs of colours perceived as completing or enhancing each other.

ANALOGOUS / HARMONIOUS COLOUR

Any one of a group of related colours that are near each other on the colour wheel, a circular chart that shows gradations of colour:

Red, orange, and yellow are analogous colours

Definition

- Gothic (goth-IK): a literary style usually portrayed fantastic tales dealing with horror, despair, the grotesque and other "dark" subjects. Gothic literature was named for the apparent influence of the dark gothic architecture of the period on the genre. Also, many of these Gothic tales took places in such "gothic" surroundings. open may people's eyes to the possible uses of the supernatural in literature.
- Charles Dickens was one of the first to incorperate this approach into his literature




Rock Art

Aboriginal rock art is the oldest form of indigenous Australian art with the earliest examples discovered at Gabarnmung in Arnhem Land dating back around 28,000 years. It is thought that there are over 100,000 rock art sites in Australia which provide a unique archive of indigenous art. These sites are sacred to Aboriginal Australians as they are inhabited by the spirits of their ancestors. Accordingly, they should be respected as holy places that embody the artistic, social, environmental and spiritual knowledge that is the lifeblood of Aboriginal culture.







Aboriginal Australians could be the oldest population of humans living outside of Africa, where one theory says they migrated from in boats 70,000 years ago. Australia's first people—known as Aboriginal Australians—have lived on the continent for over 50,000 years.
