We are delighted to invite your child to The Birley Academy for their Transition days on Monday 8<sup>th</sup>, Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> of July 2024.

Your child should attend in their **Primary school uniform** and bring a **packed lunch**, **a water bottle and snacks**. If your child is in receipt of **free school meals**, please email <a href="mailto:transition@birleysecondaryacademy.co.uk">transition@birleysecondaryacademy.co.uk</a> and we will provide a sandwich, fruit and a drink.

Your child should arrive at the main entrance of The Birley Academy **at 9am** where they will be met by members of staff and taken into the Main Hall for an assembly. They will then meet their Form Tutor and the rest of their new tutor group. We have placed children into tutor groups based on information passed on from primary schools, ensuring that they are with at least one other friend and not with other students who they do not get on with. We also ensure that the tutor groups are balanced with regards to gender, ability and SEND needs.

**Day 1** will be spent in their tutor group getting to know each other, the school and their form tutor. The day will **finish at 2.30pm.** Please ensure that you have made arrangements with your child for going home each day. If you are collecting your child please be aware that the car park does get very busy and therefore if you are able to walk to collect this is advisable.

On the second and third days of transition children will spend time with their form tutor and begin to attend lessons. On **Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> July** they will be doing PE, children should wear their Primary PE kit for school, ensure they have a water bottle and bring suncream and a hat if the weather is hot. **Days 2 and 3 will also finish at 2:30pm**. This is outlined on the next page in a table for ease of reference.

**At 5pm on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> July** there is a presentation for all our new parents and families and a chance to meet Mrs Hall, the Headteacher of The Birley Academy, the senior leadership team and your child's Head of Year, Miss Bickerstaff. Staff from Pinders Schoolwear will be in attendance.
